Thank you for your patience and willingness to work with and for the program to ensure that all our dancers are available and in participation at needed practices and performances. After marking all of your submitted schedule conflicts on the calendar, the following schedule has been created to ensure that ALL dancers are at every event.

Important dates for performing dancers: (Please ask ASAP if there are any questions!) All dates subject to change.

-Oct. 19th – First costume payment is due by this day via cash or check (\$100). Any unpaid costume payments will be pulled automatically with billing information on file on Oct. 20th with a 3% transaction fee.

-Nov. 16th – Second costume payment is due by this day via cash or check (\$100). Any unpaid costume payments will be pulled automatically with billing information on file on Nov. 17th with a 3% transaction fee.

-Jan. 14th – Costume Remainder Due. Any unpaid costume payments will be pulled automatically with billing information on file on Jan. 18th with a 3% transaction fee.

Jan. 16th & 17th – Short Dance Studios Convention. Performers only have to do Sun. the 17th but are encouraged to do both days! Only dancers participating in both days have the opportunity to receive a scholarship. Please turn in your 1/2 pg. convention form ASAP, if you haven't already, to let us know if you are doing both days and what shirt size you would like. *(approx. ages 12 and up in IGH and 11 and under in NR.)*

March 22-25th - FULL Dress Rehearsal for all NR dancers at the NR studio (hair, makeup, costumes, shoes) Parents are expected to attend!

*After all the time and effort put into dance technique, choreography, costumes, etc... this year, it is highly recommended for the dancers to attend one if not both of the additional competitions listed below. It would be great to see the dancers get more performance time up on stage. Please talk to the other members of your group to see if one or both of the below dates would work for you. It is important that we have all dancers in the group in attendance. Note: If a parent has a conflict there are many caring dance families that will take a dancer to the competition, so they don't have to miss out.
