Costume Payment Reminder

The final costume payment, per dance in the recital (not per class), for all recreational classes is due by November 16th during office hours! The teachers are finishing choosing costumes this week and the remaining balance will be calculated. These have been posted to your customer portal for you to view. It is preferred that all costume payments be made via cash or check. Any unpaid costume balances, not paid by check or cash, will be pulled in their entirety from your billing info on file with a 3% convenience fee on Nov. 17th. Competition and Performing 2nd payments are also due; \$150 for Comp and \$100 for Performing.
