The teachers are finishing choosing costumes this week and the remaining balance will be calculated. These will be posted to your customer portal for you to view in the next week. Any unpaid costume balances, not paid by check or cash, will be pulled in their entirety from your billing info on file with a 3% convenience fee on Nov. 16th. Competition and Performing 2nd payments are also due; \$200 for Comp and \$150 for Performing.
