## Costume Payment Reminder

The final costume payment, per dance in the recital (not per class) and the discounted \$35 keepsake recital package (recital tee and digital recital video = \$60 value), for all recreational classes is due by November 14<sup>th</sup> during office hours! The teachers are finishing choosing costumes this week and the remaining balance will be calculated. These will be posted to your customer portal for you to view in the next week. It is preferred that all costume payments be made via cash or check. Any unpaid costume balances, not paid by check or cash, will be pulled in their entirety from your billing info on file with a 3% convenience fee on Nov. 18<sup>th</sup>. Competition and Performing 2<sup>nd</sup> payments are also due; \$200 for Comp and \$150 for Performing.
